Final Declaration

The 8th Istanbul Economy Summit brought together leading representatives of the business world, academics, and public administrators around the main theme of "Artificial Intelligence and the Economy." The summit explored how artificial intelligence is reshaping economic dynamics by addressing its impact on business, finance, healthcare, tourism, and public administration.

Main Themes and Key Topics

1. The Impact of Artificial Intelligence on the Economy and Future Strategies

Artificial intelligence enhances efficiency in business processes, reduces costs, boosts productivity, and strengthens decision-making mechanisms. In the financial sector, AI is heavily utilized in algorithmic trading and risk management applications. In healthcare, AI-assisted diagnostic systems improve early detection. In Türkiye, the use of AI in mammography screening has accelerated the diagnostic process. In the industrial and manufacturing sectors, autonomous factories and smart production systems are gaining prominence.

2. Türkiye's AI Strategy and Global Competitiveness

Türkiye is enhancing its global competitiveness by adopting AI-driven economic models.

Public-private sector collaborations play a critical role in shaping national AI policies. Digital transformation programs must accelerate the digitalization of SMEs and large enterprises.

3. Artificial Intelligence and Employment: Workforce Transformation

The impact of AI on the workforce must be carefully managed. New technologies are transforming certain jobs while making others obsolete. Investment in human capital is essential. Education programs must be revised to train experts in AI and data science. The future of professions and the adaptation of employees to new technologies should be supported through skills development initiatives.

4. Digitalization and Sustainability

Corporate sustainability strategies should be integrated with digital transformation processes.

AI-based solutions should be employed to improve energy efficiency and reduce carbon footprints. In the tourism sector, AI is enhancing customer experience and contributing to sustainable travel planning.

Recommendations and Roadmap

National Artificial Intelligence Strategy

To position Türkiye as a global player in the field of artificial intelligence, it is essential to strengthen digital infrastructure and increase public-private sector collaborations.

The development of local AI technologies will reduce external dependency.

Education and Human Capital

Curricula in artificial intelligence and data science should be updated, and young talent should be encouraged to pursue careers in these fields.

Reskilling and upskilling programs must be expanded to transform the workforce and ensure adaptability to emerging technologies.

Artificial Intelligence and Legal Frameworks

AI-driven decision-making mechanisms must be shaped within ethical principles and robust legal frameworks. Strict regulations on personal data protection and data security should be enforced, and standards must be established to ensure fair and transparent use of AI.

Investment and Financial Support Mechanisms

AI entrepreneurs and the startup ecosystem should be supported through dedicated funds and incentive mechanisms to promote domestic technology development.

Both private and public sector institutions should increase investments in artificial intelligence technologies.

Global Cooperation and Türkiye's Positioning

Türkiye must enhance international cooperation in AI and digital transformation and take the lead in global projects that strengthen its competitive advantage. The Istanbul Economy Summit should continue to serve as a meeting ground for the international business community and academic institutions in this field.

Conclusion

The 8th Istanbul Economy Summit highlighted the critical role of artificial intelligence in economic and social transformation. It produced significant recommendations for Türkiye to adapt to the digital future and enhance its competitiveness. Hosted at Çırağan Palace, the summit continues to serve as a milestone in Türkiye's journey toward regional and global economic leadership. All stakeholders are invited to act with a shared vision to advance the digital economy and promote AI-driven innovation.

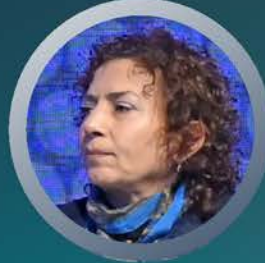

FINAL DECLARATION

Aiming to deepen economic ties between Türkiye and Europe, the Istanbul Economy Summit brought together key stakeholders of the European business community through a special edition held in Berlin in 2023. With the main theme "Investment Opportunities in Türkiye for European Companies," the summit addressed Türkiye's multidimensional investment potential—from green transformation and digitalization to sustainable tourism and electrification in the automotive industry.

The insights and proposals emerging throughout the summit highlighted Türkiye's strategic role for global investors and focused on strengthening partnerships under the following key pillars:

1. Green Transformation and Circular Economy

Within the scope of the European Green Deal and carbon neutrality goals, Türkiye has positioned itself as a strategic partner in the transition to sustainable production and consumption models. The role of SMEs in this transition is being supported by both European investors and Turkish public institutions. Organizations such as KOSGEB (Small and Medium Enterprises Development and Support Administration) offer specialized financing models for this transformation.

2. New Horizons in Sustainable Tourism

Türkiye's policies on sustainable tourism have the potential to serve as a global model. The collaboration between TGA (Turkish Tourism Promotion and Development Agency) and the GSTC (Global Sustainable Tourism Council) aims to transform the accommodation sector and position Türkiye as a sustainable destination. For European investors, significant opportunities are available across coastal tourism and alternative tourism segments.

3. A New Course for Energy and Electrification

With its growing renewable energy capacity and industrial infrastructure, Türkiye is emerging as a key player in the electrification transformation of the automotive sector. Incentives offered by the Investment Office of the Presidency of the Republic of Türkiye, particularly those tailored to green energy investments, have drawn strong interest from international investors.

4. Türkiye: Europe's Logistics and Industrial Hub

Efforts to modernize the Customs Union aim to make Türkiye a more integrated economic partner for Europe. With its strategic location, young and educated workforce, competitive cost structure, and developed infrastructure, Türkiye continues to serve as an ideal production and distribution base for Europe-based companies.

5. Multilateral Cooperation and a Shared Future

The strong economic ties between Türkiye and Germany extend beyond bilateral trade, contributing significantly to the European Union's sustainable development vision. The Berlin Summit reinforced the spirit of collaboration while also underscoring how cultural connections and interpersonal relationships enrich economic engagement.

Strategic Recommendations

- Türkiye's potential in green energy and digital transformation should be prioritized in investment decisions.
- The process to update the Customs Union with the European Union should be supported, and mutual lobbying efforts should be strengthened.
- Joint financing models that accelerate the transformation of SMEs must become a cornerstone of EU-Türkiye cooperation.
- Collaborative R&D projects should be encouraged in leading sectors such as sustainable tourism, e-mobility, and innovative textiles.
- The diaspora in Europe, especially in Germany, should be more effectively utilized as a bridge in economic diplomacy.

The Istanbul Economy Summit is more than a platform for discussion — it is a visionary center that calls for action. Such gatherings are strategic steps toward deeper economic integration between Türkiye and Europe, laying the groundwork for a sustainable and inclusive future. The Berlin Summit was not only an invitation for investment but also a call for shared values and a collective future.

Final Declaration

The 6th Istanbul Economy Summit, held on December 1–2, 2022, at the Çırağan Palace in Istanbul, took place under the main theme of Global Value Chains. The summit brought together a wide range of participants—from business leaders and ministers to representatives of international organizations and academics—offering a strategic platform for discussions on the future of both the Turkish economy and the global economic system.

The summit addressed interrelated topics such as post-pandemic economic paradigms, geopolitical disruptions, digital transformation, energy transition, and sustainable development. One of the central focuses of this year was to strengthen Turkey's position in regional and global value chains.

1. Resilient Structures and New Hubs in Global Value Chains

A key issue highlighted during the summit was the need to redesign the fragile structure of global supply chains. In strategic sectors such as energy, food, technology, and pharmaceuticals, it was emphasized that moving away from centralized production models toward multi-centered and flexible networks is essential. Turkey was noted as being well-positioned to play a leading role in this transformation, thanks to its logistics, production capacity, and human capital.

2. Strategic Transformation Opportunities for Turkey

Speakers underlined that Turkey, with its strong connections to both Asia and Europe, could serve as a natural hub for transcontinental value chains. Through digital infrastructure, a green economy, and public-private partnerships, Turkey can be integrated into these chains with higher added value. The summit also called for support of the entrepreneurial ecosystem and the training of young talent in fields such as artificial intelligence and data science.

3. A New Economy Focused on Sustainability and Digitalization

Transformation was discussed not only in economic terms but also in environmental and social dimensions. For sustainable growth, efficient use of natural resources, reduced carbon emissions, and the integration of digital technologies into production processes were emphasized. In particular, it was stressed that sectors such as automotive, energy, and tourism must pursue digitalization and sustainability in tandem, with a focus on smart transportation, green production, and data-driven decision-making.

4. Multilateral Cooperation and New Diplomatic Perspectives

The participation of high-level representatives from Albania, Azerbaijan, North Macedonia, and Kosovo underscored the significance of economic diplomacy. Joint projects, digital economy integration, energy cooperation, and mutual investment support programs were among the proposals discussed.

5. Sectoral Depth: Defense, Tourism, Energy, Health, and FinTech

Sector-specific panels brought key themes to the forefront:

- **Defense Industry:** Turkey's strategy to reduce foreign dependency through national technologies and its potential in global exports.
- **Tourism:** The rise of digitalization, personalized experiences, and AI-powered customer services.
- **Energy:** Developments in e-mobility, renewable energy investments, and sustainable infrastructure.
- **Health:** Use of digital twins, clinical decision support systems, and AI-assisted diagnostic technologies.
- **FinTech:** Data security, open banking, and AI-based credit scoring systems.

Conclusion and Recommendations

The Istanbul Economy Summit highlighted the following strategic steps for Turkey to become a strong, resilient, and agile actor in evolving global value chains:

- Digitalization and the green transition must be addressed together, with public policies designed to support this dual transformation.
- SMEs, entrepreneurs, and young professionals should be more actively involved in global value chains, with improved access to technology.
- Public-private cooperation must be expanded to ensure that major transformations are managed in a comprehensive manner—not just by the state.
- Regional cooperation networks should be established, particularly enhancing trade relations with the Balkans, Central Asia, and the Middle East.
- The investment environment should be made more attractive by ensuring data security, reducing bureaucratic hurdles, and increasing legal predictability.

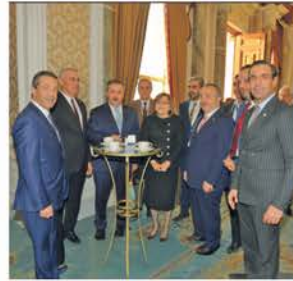
The Summit's Mission: Istanbul's Global Role

Final Declaration

The 5th Istanbul Economy Summit was held on December 10, 2021, at Çırağan Palace in Istanbul under the main theme of "Green Economy." With broad participation from public institutions, private sector representatives, academia, and the media, the summit offered a multidimensional evaluation of Turkey's role in the green transformation process and its opportunities for sustainable development in harmony with the global system.

Throughout the summit, interrelated topics such as climate change mitigation, environmental sustainability, digitalization, energy transition, and next-generation development models were discussed simultaneously. The potential leadership role Turkey could assume in this transformation was examined from various perspectives.

1. Structural Transformation and Sectoral Adaptation in the Green Economy

One of the key highlights of the summit was the need to balance economic growth with environmental sustainability. The importance of policies that would enhance resource efficiency, reduce carbon emissions, and support the circular economy model across agriculture, energy, industry, and services sectors was emphasized. In particular, the alignment between climate-focused public policies and private sector initiatives was considered a fundamental pillar of this transformation.

2. Digitalization, Smart Systems, and Green Technologies

Digital technologies were spotlighted as critical enablers of a successful green economy. From smart transportation systems and energy-efficient digital infrastructures to data-driven decision-making mechanisms and AI-supported processes, participants stressed the importance of integrating these tools into green transformation. It was underlined that green digitalization is not only an environmental imperative but also a strategic asset in terms of economic competitiveness.

3. Sustainable Finance, Investment, and Entrepreneurship

The summit frequently addressed the promotion of sustainability-oriented investments and the financing of environmentally friendly projects. There was a call to expand the use of financial instruments such as green bonds and sustainable funds. It was also noted that a new economic balance could be achieved through the leadership of public banks and the entrepreneurial drive of the private sector. Participants further emphasized the importance of supporting green entrepreneurship and social impact investing.

4. Global Alignment, International Standards, and Climate Agreements

Turkey's alignment with international climate agreements—especially the European Green Deal—and global environmental standards was deemed essential for ensuring the sustainability of its export capacity. Participants highlighted the importance of being prepared for new regulations such as carbon border adjustment mechanisms and proposed the widespread adoption of environmental certification systems for exporters.

5. Employment, Education, and New-Generation Professions

The summit also addressed the new job areas, skills, and professions emerging as a result of green transformation. The importance of introducing young people to climate-friendly professions, increasing vocational transformation programs, and reshaping education policies to prioritize green skills was underscored. Additionally, the role of green transformation projects in empowering women's employment was emphasized.

Conclusions and Recommendations

The 5th Istanbul Economy Summit underscored that the transition to a green economy requires a multilayered transformation—not only environmental but also economic and social. The key recommendations highlighted at the summit include:

- Green and digital transformation should be designed together, and public policies should be redesigned to facilitate this integration.
- Innovative solutions that reduce carbon emissions should be supported, and energy efficiency and clean production practices should be scaled up.
- Green finance models should be developed, and the ecosystem for sustainability-focused entrepreneurship should be strengthened.
- Climate-resilient infrastructures should be built, and risk reduction strategies should be integrated into sectoral planning.
- Education policies should be restructured to focus on green skills and environmentally friendly professions.

Summit Mission: From Istanbul to a Green Future

The Istanbul Economy Summit continues to serve as a strategic platform of knowledge and guidance for policy-makers at both national and international levels during the green transition. With this summit, Istanbul further positions itself as a global actor with a comprehensive development vision that prioritizes both environmental and economic sustainability.

Final Declaration

The 4th Istanbul Economy Summit brought together public and private sector representatives, academics, and opinion leaders in Istanbul to discuss the restructuring of the global economy in line with sustainable development goals. The panels held during the Summit evaluated economic, environmental, and social transformation processes from a multidimensional perspective.

The main message of the Summit was the need for the current global economic system to evolve into a structure that both respects the planet's limited resources and ensures a fairer distribution of income and opportunity. In this context, the following themes stood out:

1. The Need for New Economic Paradigms

Global financial imbalances, increasing inequality, and the climate crisis have rendered current economic models unsustainable. The Summit emphasized the importance of shifting from growth-oriented economic policies to more inclusive, environmentally conscious, and human-centered models.

2. Green Transformation and the Digital Economy

The transition to green energy, low-carbon economies, and circular production systems was discussed as a fundamental component of sustainable development. Digital transformation was also highlighted as an effective tool for achieving sustainability goals. Participants proposed the use of technologies such as artificial intelligence, blockchain, and big data for sustainable economic planning.

3. The Role and Responsibility of Financial Systems

The financial sector holds the power not only to direct capital flows but also to influence the sustainability of investments. The Summit emphasized that Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) criteria must play a central role in financial decision-making processes. The widespread adoption of sustainable finance instruments was also underlined.

4. Global Cooperation and Multilateralism

Post-pandemic supply chain disruptions and geopolitical tensions have prompted a re-evaluation of economic dependencies. Summit discussions stressed the importance of strengthening international cooperation, maintaining multilateral trade frameworks, and fostering collective responsibility in development projects.

5. Social Inclusion and Education

The Summit emphasized that global economic restructuring must prioritize not only economic growth but also social justice and inclusivity. It advocated for the development of policies and mechanisms that support the active participation of youth and women in the economy. The need to align education systems with digital and green skills was also highlighted.

Conclusion and Recommendations

The 4th Istanbul Economy Summit drew attention to the necessity of structurally redefining the global economy in order to achieve sustainable development goals. Based on the key takeaways from the Summit, the following strategic recommendations were presented:

- Environmental limits, social justice, and economic resilience must be addressed together in redefining the global economy.
- Investments in green energy, digital infrastructure, and the circular economy should be treated not only as environmental imperatives but also as strategic priorities.
- Public-private partnerships should serve as key levers in accelerating sustainable transformation.
- Financial systems must integrate ESG criteria into their decision-making processes, and green bonds and sustainable investment tools should be promoted.
- Multilateral cooperation mechanisms must be strengthened to achieve global development goals; economic relations should be rebuilt on the principles of trust, transparency, and mutual benefit.
- The active participation of youth and women must be ensured, and education policies should be swiftly implemented to equip individuals with digital and green skills.

The Summit served not only as a platform for discussion but also as a call to action. Following through on the recommendations shared during this journey toward sustainable development will contribute to establishing shared prosperity and environmental balance at both the national and global levels.

Final Declaration

The 3rd Istanbul Economy Summit was held in Istanbul to assess Türkiye's and the world's adaptation to the emerging new world order in light of the rapid global changes and transformations. The summit addressed, in a comprehensive manner, the innovations in economic, technological, and social spheres—along with the opportunities and challenges brought by these developments.

1. Digital Transformation and Technological Advancements

With the rapid pace of technological development, digital transformation has become central to both business and society. The summit featured discussions on the impact of artificial intelligence, big data, and the Internet of Things on economic and social structures. In this context, it was emphasized that businesses and institutions must accelerate their digitalization processes and invest in developing a digitally competent workforce.

2. Sustainable Economic Models

Global economic uncertainty and volatility have increased the importance of sustainable and resilient economic models. The summit underlined the necessity of adopting green economy principles, circular production systems, and sustainable financing methods as essential strategies for long-term economic stability.

3. Education and Human Capital Development

Adapting to the new world order requires updating educational systems to align with future needs. Participants stressed the importance of integrating critical thinking, problem-solving, and digital literacy into curricula. Furthermore, fostering a culture of lifelong learning and ensuring that individuals continuously update their skills were highlighted as strategic priorities.

4. Global Cooperation and Multilateralism

In the face of globalization's opportunities and challenges, the summit emphasized the rising importance of international cooperation and multilateral diplomacy. Strengthening collaborative efforts in areas such as trade, security, and environmental policy was considered essential to building shared solutions.

5. Social Inclusion and Equality

In the emerging world order, adopting principles of inclusivity and equality is of great significance. Discussions focused on the need for concrete policies and practices that ensure gender equality, equal opportunity, and social justice.

Conclusions and Recommendations

The 3rd Istanbul Economy Summit recommends the following strategic actions in preparation for the new world order:

- Investing in digitalization and technology to increase competitiveness.
- Embracing sustainable and environmentally friendly economic models.
- Adapting educational systems to meet future demands and promoting a culture of lifelong learning.
- Strengthening international collaborations and supporting multilateral diplomatic relations.
- Mainstreaming social inclusion and equality into policy and practice.

The summit concludes with the conviction that through joint effort and stakeholder cooperation, both Türkiye and the global community can successfully adapt to the evolving global landscape.

Final Declaration

Held in Istanbul amidst the economic uncertainty brought on by global trade wars, the 2nd Istanbul Economy Summit aimed to assess Türkiye's strategic position at both regional and global levels, its investment opportunities, and its resilient economic structure. The summit brought together representatives from various sectors—ranging from industry and finance to energy, construction, tourism, and transportation—as well as thought leaders and policymakers. Discussions focused on current global economic dynamics and Türkiye's vast potential.

1. The New Dynamics of Global Trade Wars

In an era marked by rising protectionism and the reemergence of trade barriers, Türkiye's production capacity and logistical strengths offer an attractive foundation for new investment routes. The summit emphasized Türkiye's role as a strategic bridge between Asia and Europe, highlighting its importance for emerging supply chains and regional trade networks.

2. Türkiye's Investment Climate and Sectoral Opportunities

Recent developments in key sectors such as industry, finance, energy, construction, tourism, automotive, and logistics were discussed in depth. The summit highlighted emerging investment areas focused on digital transformation, green transition, and high value-added production. Türkiye's incentive mechanisms, young and dynamic population, and strong growth potential were also underlined as key factors of interest for both domestic and international investors.

3. Financial Stability and the Importance of a Trustworthy Environment

It was stressed that fostering a strong investment climate requires financial transparency, legal certainty, and predictable economic policies. With global capital flows undergoing transformation, Türkiye's ability to strengthen its financial infrastructure was deemed essential.

4. Public-Private Partnerships and the Reform Agenda

To achieve sustainable success in global competition, the need for deeper cooperation between the public and private sectors was highlighted. Enhancing digitalization, R&D, green energy, and innovation efforts through public support is expected to create significant competitive advantages.

5. Regional Diplomacy and Multilateral Economic Relations

Despite ongoing global trade tensions, Türkiye must deepen its international cooperation through multilateral diplomacy and economic partnerships. Strategic alliances with alternative markets will enhance the country's economic resilience.

Conclusions and Recommendations

The Istanbul Economy Summit outlined the following strategic actions to help Türkiye maintain economic growth and maximize its investment appeal in the face of global trade conflicts:

- Support high value-added production in strategic sectors and boost R&D investments
- Implement pioneering policies in digital transformation, green transition, and sustainability
- Establish a transparent, robust, and investor-friendly financial market structure
- Strengthen the legal and institutional framework to ensure confidence among international investors
- Promote public-private cooperation and maintain a committed reform agenda
- Diversify Türkiye's multilateral economic relations to mitigate trade-related risks

The summit reaffirmed its belief that with the right policies and strong partnerships, Türkiye can capitalize on its strategic advantages and emerge as a regional investment hub amid the ongoing global economic transformation.

FINAL DECLARATION

The 1st Istanbul Economy Summit, held on December 25, 2017 at Çırağan Palace, was organized to assess the opportunities and challenges Türkiye faces in its digital transformation journey. With broad participation from public institutions, the private sector, academia, and civil society, the summit thoroughly explored the impact of Industry 4.0 on the Turkish economy.

1. Digital Transformation and Technological Innovation

Industry 4.0 refers to the digitalization of production processes, the rise of automation, and the integration of technologies such as artificial intelligence. The summit emphasized the need for Türkiye to strengthen its digital infrastructure, promote R&D investments, and support innovation in order to enhance its competitiveness during this transformation.

2. Education and Human Capital Development

The successful implementation of Industry 4.0 requires a qualified workforce. Participants stressed the importance of aligning the education system with the needs of the new era, increasing training in STEM fields (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), and promoting a culture of lifelong learning.

3. Sustainability and Green Transformation

Industry 4.0 technologies contribute to sustainability through energy efficiency and responsible resource use. The summit highlighted the need to adopt environmentally friendly production methods, reduce carbon footprints, and implement circular economy models.

4. Global Competitiveness and Cooperation

To strengthen its international competitiveness in the Industry 4.0 era, Türkiye must prioritize global cooperation. Strategic steps such as aligning with international standards, facilitating technology transfer, and encouraging foreign investment were identified as key actions.

5. Digitalization of SMEs

Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises (SMEs) form the backbone of the Turkish economy. The summit emphasized the importance of integrating SMEs into the digital transformation process by increasing financial support and improving digital literacy.

Conclusions and Recommendations

To succeed in the Industry 4.0 transition, the Istanbul Economy Summit proposes the following strategic actions:

- Strengthening digital infrastructure and increasing technological investments
- Aligning the education system with Industry 4.0 and developing a qualified workforce
- Adopting sustainable and environmentally friendly production models
- Enhancing international cooperation and compliance with global standards
- Supporting the integration of SMEs into the digital transformation process

The summit affirms its belief that through collaboration and joint efforts from all stakeholders, Türkiye can successfully advance in the Industry 4.0 era.
